The red chair)) In turn, pupils could sit in the hot seat and assume the identity of Dyf. They should answer questions asked by the group: Sut wyt ti? (How are you?) Pwy wyt ti? (Who are you?) Ble wyt ti? (Where are you?) Beth wyt ti'n wneud? (What are you doing?) Sut wyt ti'n teimlo? (How do you feel?) Dw i'n teimlo'n hapus / nerfus / ofnus. (I feel happy / nervous / frightened.) Wyt ti'n hoffi ...? (Do you like ...?) Ydw. / Nac ydw. (Yes, I do. / No, I don't). Beth sy tu allan? (What's outside?) • Collage / Mobile In groups, pupils could make a collage or mobile to depict camping in the woods - during the day or during the night. The following patterns should be used: Beth wyt ti'n ddefnyddio? (What are you (sing.) using?) » Dw i'n ddefnyddio ... (I'm using ...) Beth ydych chi'n ddefnyddio? (What are you (pl.) using?) » Rydyn ni'n defnyddio... (We're using ...) The artwork could then be compared: Yn y dydd, mae ... yn y goedwig. (In the day, there is / are ... in the woods.) Yn y nos, mae ... yn y goedwig. (At night, there is / are ... in the woods.) The work should be evaluated: Dw i'n hoffi'r gwaith / collage / symudyn. (I like the work / collage / mobile.) Mae'r ... yn dda / effeithiol. (The ... is / are good / effective.) Mae angen mwya o ... yma. (More ... is needed here.) • Pupils could guess what's outside the tent.

Using the information contained in the book, the pupil playing the part of Izzy could reply, e.g. Ble wyt ti? (Where are you?) » Dw i ... (I'm ...) » Dw i ddim yn gwybod. (I don't know.) Beth wyt ti'n gallu gweld? (What can you see?) » Dw i'n gallu gweld ... (I can see ...) • Pupils could draw images associated with different aspects of the story and write sentences to describe what is happening. • Pupils could search for images associated with Australia and label them: Dyma ... (This is ... / These are ...) • They could also search for more information about the kangaroo and koala and write simply: Dyma'r ... (This is the ... / These are the ...) Mae'n byw yn ... (It lives in ...) Mae'n bwytá ... (It eats ...) Maen nhw'n byw yn ... (They live in ...) Maen nhw'n bwytá ... (They eat ...) • Pupils could look in a Welsh atlas and describe Izzy's journey from Wales to Australia. They could plot her journey on individual maps. • Pupils could also search for more information about the people / periods referred to in the book.
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
